The opulent Bellagio is the first Las Vegas resort and casino to receive the AAA Five Diamond Award.

at work

Elegant and functional, Bellagio's meeting facilities accommodate groups large and small. The 45,000-square-foot Grand Ballroom seats up to 4,700 theater style or hosts banquets for 2,900 attendees. Equally impressive are the 30,000-square-foot Tower Ballroom and the 22,000-square-foot Bellagio Ballroom. The Monet Room offers the option of indoor/outdoor entertaining with a beautiful patio overlooking the pool and courtyards. Another 25 meeting rooms range in size from 500 to 10,000 square feet. Each is equipped with speakerphones and dataports, plus built-in screens, wireless access, projectors, and speakerphones. Additional audiovisual equipment is also available for group needs. Planners may also take advantage of Tuscany Kitchen for a culinary experience designed with meeting and convention groups in mind. For occasions that require an imaginative touch, Bellagio provides access to MGM Mirage Events which is available to assist with props, graphics, invitations, floral, and entertainment.

at rest

Bellagio is home to 3,933 luxurious guest rooms and suites, all appointed with custom furnishings, fine art, and conveniences such as high-speed Internet access, multiple phone lines, a minibar, and electronic drapes. Sophisticated and elegant, the guest rooms feature views of The Las Vegas Strip, the famous Fountains of Bellagio, or the mountains of Southern Nevada.





at play

Bellagio offers entertainment to suit any style, including a plethora of elegant gaming options in more than 100,000 square feet of gaming space. The resort features an eight-acre lake that comes alive with more than 1,200 dancing fountains that enchant visitors with soaring waters. Bellagio is also home to Cirque du Soleil's renowned "O," where an international cast of world-class acrobats, synchronized swimmers, divers, and characters perform in, on, and above a 1.5-million-gallon pool. The Bellagio Gallery of Fine Art currently features *In the Master's Hands: Picasso's Ceramics, Treasures From the Estate of Pablo Picasso*. The Conservatory and Botanical Gardens, upscale shopping, and a luxurious 65,000-square-foot Spa and Salon also entice visitors. Tee times can be arranged at area golf courses. A number of bars and lounges, including the stylish Light nightclub, offer after-hours diversions.

at the table

Nineteen establishments run the gamut from the French haute cuisine of Le Cirque, a AAA Five Diamond Award winner, to innovative French cuisine set off by original Picasso paintings and ceramics at AAA Five Diamond Picasso. Circo is the place for upscale, homestyle Italian cuisine, while Prime offers first-class steaks, seafood, and lamb. Sensi, FIX, Michael Mina Bellagio, Jasmine, Shintaro, and Noodles round out Bellagio's fine culinary offerings. Bellagio Buffet features cuisines from around the world and there are additional casual options.
