at work

With 11 meeting rooms and more than 22,000 square feet of meeting space, Hotel Nikko offers planners a wealth of choices for up to 800 people. Options include the elegant Nikko Ballroom, with 6,658 square feet of space (divisible into three), as well as three boardrooms. All meeting rooms on the 25th floor offer stunning panoramic views of the city and the bay.

at rest

Hotel Nikko features 532 guest rooms and 22 suites, all with full-sized desks and high-speed Internet access. Other high-tech amenities include dual-line speaker-phones with dataports and personalized voicemail, as well as 42-inch plasma televisions. Nikko Rooms (on the 20th and 21st floors) add in fax machines, stereo systems with CD player, and private lounge, while Imperial Floor rooms (on the 23rd, 24th, and 25th floors) go a step farther with private elevator access,

Frette linens, VIBE TV in the bathroom, and complimentary buffet breakfast and happy hour in either Restaurant ANZU or the exclusive concierge lounge.

at play

Within walking distance of Union Square, Hotel Nikko offers the best of a world-class hotel with all the excitement and activities of a world-class city right outside its door. The hotel is within easy reach of the Museum of Modern Art, South of Market, the Theater District, and the Financial District, as well as BART, MUNI, and San Francisco's famed cable cars. Regardless of the weather outside, it's always perfect in the fifth-floor solarium, complete with indoor swimming pool and whirlpool. A state-of-the-art health club is open 24 hours a day, and there's also a sauna and traditional Japanese meditation rooms. Shiatsu massages are available by appointment; the hotel plans to add a spa next year.

at the table

The hotel is home to one of San Francisco's most acclaimed restaurants, ANZU. Offering EuroJapanese cuisine, ANZU is known for its distinctive menu, which features quality prime beef, imported daily from the Midwest, and the freshest sushi and sashimi at the sushi bar, managed by the former chef of the royal family of Japan. The cocktail bar serves up signature sake martinis, as well as other choices, and features live piano entertainment. A Starbucks is on site as well, and room service is available 24 hours a day. The centrally located hotel is near a variety of off-site dining options.
