The Hilton Ballroom and Pavillion, both divisible spaces, combine to form a columnfree space that could span two football fields and will accommodate up to 10,000 guests. The 70,000-square-foot Hilton Center, which is divisible into two pillarless rooms and features 25-foot ceilings, can hold almost 9,000 delegates. There are also 14 conference rooms totaling 9,385 square feet, a 14-seat boardroom, and a 16-seat Executive Boardroom with U-shaped conference table. The hotel's Audio/Video Services Department provides top-of-the-line equipment and professional technicians. The Las Vegas Hilton has convenient access via the Skywalk Bridge to the Las Vegas Convention Center, supplying planners with easy access to an additional 3 million square feet of exhibit space.

The hotel's casino features a wide selection of table games, slot and video poker machines, and the world's largest race and sports book. The pool and recreation deck has fully stocked private cabanas and lounge chairs. The Spa at the Las Vegas Hilton offers a fitness center, steam rooms, saunas, and a luxurious menu of skin and massage treatments. Rooftop tennis courts are located adjacent to the recreation deck, and the Regis Salon and Sports Zone Video Arcade are also on site.

Star Trek: The Experience is a unique and exciting attraction where guests can witness a Klingon Encounter and a BORG Invasion in four dimensions. Fans can continue the fun as they eat at Quark's Bar & Restaurant, shop at Zek's Grand Emporium and Moogle's Trading Post, and get an inside look at Star Trek in The History of the Future Museum.

Nighttime entertainment includes performances by such stars as Barry Manilow, Brooks & Dunn, Diana Krall, and George Lopez. For further amusement, guests can catch *Menopause The Musical* in the Shimmer Cabaret.



at the table

Both casual and fine dining await guests at the Las Vegas Hilton, and the challenge for guests lies in selecting from the long list of tantalizing eateries. Dining highlights include Casa Nicola, where guests can watch chefs prepare Northern Italian and Mediterranean coast cuisine in an exhibition kitchen; Garden of the Dragon, for upscale Chinese fare; TJ's Steakhouse, serving prime beef in a setting of rich mahogany furniture and contemporary art; 888 Noodle Bar, showcasing Pan-Asian specialties cooked in an exhibition kitchen; Teru Sushi, home to an authentic sushi bar; and the world-renowned Benihana, featuring master chefs demonstrating their skills on hibachi tables.
