at work

Large groups will find plenty of room to convene in the 640,000-square-foot Greater Richmond Convention Center, which features 178,159 square feet of exhibit space, a 30,550-square-foot ballroom, and 38 meeting rooms. Unique offsite venues include the Virginia Aviation Museum and the Pocahontas State Park.

at rest

The Richmond area currently offers nearly 16,000 hotel rooms. The \$80 million Miller & Rhoads Hilton, scheduled to open in Fall 2008 across the street from the convention center, will have 250 guest rooms, 20,000 square feet of retail space, and 7,000 square feet of meeting space.

at play

Richmond offers visitors a wide variety of activities and attractions, including roller coasters at Kings Dominion, white-water rafting, and an interpretation of early 17th-century life at Henricus Historical Park. There's also the Lewis Ginter Botanical Garden, Metro Richmond Zoo, Virginia Museum of Fine Arts, and several unique shopping districts.
