A contemporary hotel in the heart of Orlando, Rosen Plaza sets the stage for first-class meetings and conferences.



at work

Located in the heart of the International Drive convention and vacation area, Rosen Plaza is home to more than 60,000 square feet of sophisticated meeting and exhibition space. Groups of 10 to 2,800 can convene in the modern and elegant 26,000-square-foot Grand Ballroom, which is complemented by the 12,500-square-foot Ballroom Foyer. There are an additional 18 meeting rooms, including the Regency Salon junior ballrooms. Ballrooms and the breakout salons will soon receive a makeover, thanks to an ongoing renovation project. There are two permanent registration areas

with locking storage. Advanced audiovisual capabilities and support, teleconferencing, simultaneous translation, and full banquet and catering services are available, as is a complete business center for any last-minute needs.

For smaller groups, two 1,000-square-foot Presidential suites can accommodate up to 50 guests, while 16 hospitality suites—600 square feet each—have enough room for intimate gatherings of up to 30. Each of these suites is furnished with a boardroom table, and the Presidential suites have full kitchens and wet bars.

As the hotel looks to the future, an expansion that will add 400 rooms and 120,000 square feet of additional meeting space is in the works, although full details have not yet been made available. In the meantime, if groups need to expand, the hotel's convenient location next to the 2.1 million-square-foot Orange County Convention Center makes it easy to do just that.





at rest

Currently, Rosen Plaza Hotel provides 800 deluxe guest rooms, including 32 suites. The comfortably appointed accommodations already feature a host of thoughtful touches—such as richly colored wood furniture, an impressive armoire, attractive fabrics in a refreshing blend of yellows and greens, and an oversized work desk—and will soon receive new bedding packages as part of the ongoing renovation. All rooms have high-speed Internet access, dataport, voicemail, in-room safe, coffeemaker, and cable television with in-room movies and video games. Executive King suites offer additional amenities like a wet bar and dining area with seating for four.

at play

Relaxation at Rosen Plaza comes easy, thanks to a swimming pool area with a cascading waterfall and whirlpool, as well as a fitness center with cardio exercise machines and a full range of free weights. Guests are also granted privileges at the Shingle Creek Golf Club just five minutes away. The new David Harman-designed, 18-hole championship course can be used for group tournaments and individual play. There's also a state-of-the-art Brad Brewer Golf Academy, perfect for teambuilding golf clinics, and on-site function space.

Rosen Plaza's location puts guests just minutes away from all of Orlando's famous attractions. Thanks to its designation as a "Destination Universal Hotel," the resort provides complimentary transportation to Universal Orlando, SeaWorld Adventure Park, and Wet 'n Wild waterpark. Walt Disney World Theme Parks are

also just 10 minutes away and are accessible via the I-Ride Trolley, which stops just outside the resort. And if guests yearn for shopping beyond the hotel's gift and sundry shop, they can head across the street to Pointe Orlando, a 17-acre shopping complex that offers multiple dining and entertainment venues, including an IMAX 3D theater. Guests can also browse through the goods the Florida Mall, Mall at Millenia, and Prime Outlet Mall (one of the largest of its kind in the country)—all located nearby.

at the table

Rosen Plaza Hotel offers a selection of restaurants for both leisure dining experiences and meals on the go. The award-winning Jack's Place, famous for its steak and seafood, boasts the world's largest collection of autographed caricatures of celebrities and dignitaries, all of which are displayed along the restaurant's walls. Jack's Place is open to the public for dinner, but can be used by smaller groups for private breakfast and lunch. Cafe Matisse offers a more casual setting for bountiful buffets and a full menu of breakfast, lunch, and dinner entrees. For those in a hurry, there's the Smooth Java coffee bar; Rossini's Pizza for freshly made pizzas and other Italian specialties; and Lite Bite, the 24-hour restaurant with deli sandwiches, snacks, and convenience items. Rosen Plaza is also home to International Plaza's original nightclub, Backstage, which features live entertainment with Soundtrax.
