# rosen shingle creek

first time winner

**The new 230-acre Rosen Shingle Creek opened in September 2006 with enough amenities and activities on site that guests might never want to leave.**

## at work

More than 450,000 square feet of meeting and event space—along with state-of-the-art technology and exquisite catering—makes Rosen Shingle Creek an ideal choice for everything from intimate VIP retreats to banquets of up to 9,400 attendees. The 95,000-square-foot Gatlin Ballroom, one of the largest column-free ballrooms in the United States, anchors the hotel's offerings, which also include the 60,000-square-foot Sebastian Ballroom and the 40,000-square-foot Panzicola Ballroom. The three ballrooms have 31-foot ceil-



ings and are served by 17 load-in bays. Additional indoor space is found in 55,000 square feet of breakout rooms, including the 4,067-square-foot Butler Room and its 2,978-square-foot balcony, and more than 100,000 square feet of prefunction space. Outdoor events can make use of the 40,000-square-foot terrace





and 39,000 square feet of staging area. The hotel is also just minutes away from the Orange County Convention Center, which provides an additional 2.1 million square feet of meeting and exhibition space.

#### at rest

Rosen Shingle Creek boasts 1,500 oversized guest rooms, including 139 suites, decorated in the early 1900s Spanish Revival style. All rooms provide beautiful views of the golf course, creek, or lush vegetation. The rooms are among the largest in central Florida and feature high-speed Internet access, 32-inch flat-screen televisions with movie service, mini-fridge, laptop safe, and two telephones. Additional luxury comes by way of special touches like plush robes, Egyptian cotton sheets, down alternative blankets, first-class bath products, and elegant furnishings. NXTV connectivity allows guests to send room-to-room emails and make tee times from the comfort of their rooms.

#### at play

Guests of Rosen Shingle Creek will never want for things to do, with the hotel's wide assortment of indoor and outdoor activities. The 13,000-square-foot, full-service Spa at Shingle Creek has nine treatment rooms and a state-of-the-art fitness center, while the Shingle Creek Golf Club features an award-winning, 18-hole championship course designed by David Harman as well as a Brad Brewer Gold Academy. Glow-in-the-Dark Golf is also available to groups. There are on-site facilities for tennis, basketball, tetherball, and sand volleyball, along with four outdoor swimming pools and

two hot tubs. Nature trails and in-season fishing also get attendees outdoors. Spouse programs include on-site cooking classes helmed by the hotel's award-winning pastry chef, David Ramirez, and The Swamp Kids' Program offers supervised activities and play areas. And with its location in the heart of Orlando, Rosen Shingle Creek puts guests within easy distance of top area attractions, such as Walt Disney World, Sea World, Universal Orlando, Wet 'n Wild waterpark.

#### at the table

Rosen Shingle Creek has 12 restaurants and lounges that are perfect for small gatherings or individual dining experiences. Dine-arounds are popular for larger groups. The 150-seat A Land Remembered steakhouse, the property's newest restaurant, was created as a tribute to Florida's frontier past. Cala Bella ("Beautiful Creek") offers fine Italian dining in a bistro setting with presentation cooking and the Bella's Bar piano bar in its vestibule. There's also Cafe Osceola and Osceola Bar, serving a la carte menus three meals a day in a room with floor-to-ceiling windows; 18 Monroe Street Market, a 24-hour deli with dine-in and take-out options; Smooth Java coffee and juice bar with assorted pastries and snacks; Creek Ice Creamery; Headwaters Lounge lobby bar for cocktails; and Cat-Tails Pool Bar & Grille, offering poolside access to a variety of food and drink options. Room service is also available 24 hours a day.
