# sheraton waikiki

## at work

A modern monument to traditional Hawaiian hospitality, the Sheraton Waikiki's 56,000 square feet of flexible indoor and outdoor meeting space is some of the most accommodating on Oahu, offering the latest in wireless connectivity, lighting, and state-of-the-art videoconferencing. The 25,900-square-foot Hawaii Ballroom is the largest hotel ballroom on the island and includes a complete catwalk and theatrical lighting system. The 7,200-square-foot ballroom foyer can be used for receptions, exhibits, hospitality services, and other events. An additional 19 meeting rooms support this convention property, as well as a business center and dramatic outdoor venues. The 17,000-square-foot oceanfront Diamond Head Lawn is a quintessential Hawaiian setting for theme parties. The property is also within a five-minute drive of the stunning Hawaii Convention Center, one of the most high-tech centers in the country.

## at rest

A full 80 percent of the property's 1,695 guest accommodations offer beautiful ocean views from private lanais. Each room is decorated in calming sand-and-sea shades, punctuated with tropical colors. A writing desk, dual-line phone with voicemail and dataport, and luxury bath and amenities are standard. The 128 spacious suites come in several types and offer upgraded amenities, such as morning coffee service and evening turndown service.

## at play

The activities of Waikiki Beach keep attendees busy during leisure time with surfing lessons, snorkeling, and just plain sun worshipping. The hotel also offers two outdoor swimming pools and a fully equipped fitness facility. Off-property attractions include Diamond Head, where a one-mile foot trail leads to a 360-degree summit view; the Arizona Memorial and *U.S.S. Missouri*, the Waikiki Aquarium, Honolulu Zoo, Bishop Museum for Polynesian artifacts, and the Iolani Palace, the former home of King Kamehameha III built in 1845. Planners will definitely want to arrange island excursions to spectacular lookout points and, of course, tee times at some of Hawaii's finest golf courses. Three jogging trails are nearby the hotel. Also nearby, Kapiolani Park's tennis courts, open to the public and lit for night play. Shoppers have their pick of choices, from the Royal Hawaiian Shopping
