## at work

The Island Hotel features more than 30,000 square feet of meeting and function space, including two grand ballrooms: The nearly 7,000-square-foot Palm Garden ballroom includes a permanent stage and wide rear doors to allow automobile access, and there's also a 6,600-square-foot traditional ballroom, divisible by two. Five meeting rooms have outdoor terraces and are equipped with built-in screens and marker boards, and five additional meeting suites accommodate from 10 to 18 attendees conference style. Canopy-style cabanas, lush tropical foliage, and a fireplace with conversation area create an intimate space at the Pool Upper Terrace for receptions and dinners.

## at rest

Attendees have their choice of 295 beautifully appointed guest rooms, including 63 Executive Suites, with secluded bedroom, separate living room, and furnished balcony overlooking the pool or gardens, and 20 spacious Luxury Suites. All rooms offer a step-out balcony or furnished patio, many with commanding views of the Pacific Ocean and Newport Harbor, as well as marble bathrooms, iron and ironing board, multi-line telephones with speakerphone, high-speed Internet connection, and the "Perfect Sleep" system with exclusively designed mattresses, 100-percent Egyptian cotton bed linens from Italy, and 100-percent goose down duvets and pillows.



## at play

The 4,000-square-foot Spa at the Island Hotel is a soothing first-class sanctuary with nine treatment rooms for more than 30 different types of massages and treatments, including exotic signature services such as the Island Boreh Bali Spice Remedy and the Island Volcanic Detoxifying Wrap. Complimentary fitness facilities are located adjacent to the resort-style pool, featuring the latest in exercise technology. Two outdoor lighted tennis courts are on site and groups can get preferred tee times at the nearby Oak Creek Golf Club, a Tom Fazio-designed 18-hole course set against the backdrop of the mountains.

## at the table

Groups can enjoy a leisurely meal poolside amid lush gardens and graceful palms or a refreshing cocktail at the Palapa Bar. The signature Palm Terrace Restaurant and Lounge reopened in June after a stylish interior redesign with a tropical oasis ambiance. Award-winning dining is directed by world-recognized Executive Chef Bill Bracken, including a full menu, small plates, and "small bites," encouraging customized menus. The lounge features live entertainment, signature cocktails, and new concoctions like the "a la mode" Zinc 17th, made with house-infused ginger vodka, soda, honey, and herbs.
