Nestled among the Adirondacks on the shores of Lake George, The Sagamore has modern-day amenities and historic appeal on its very own private island.

at play

Guests of the resort will find exciting recreation options year-round. On property there are six tennis courts and a racquetball court, sailing school, fitness center, indoor heated pool and whirlpool, beach, and marina with watersports. The newly renovated, full-service Sagamore Spa offers signature treatments—such as the Sacred Earth Healing Ritual, a massage and exfoliation using medicinal herbs and aromatic steam, and facials and massages that incorporate Crystalline Consciousness Technique—and a large menu of relaxing and rejuvenating services, along with a sauna, eucalyptus steam room, and Jacuzzi. The 9,000-square-foot Challenge Course, perfect for teambuilding activities, has a ropes course, climbing wall, and activity area. A free shuttle whisks golfers to the mainland for the hotel's par-70 Donald Ross-designed course.

at the table

Dining at The Sagamore is always a first-class culinary experience. Options in the main building include the AAA Four Diamond Trillium bis, the hotel's new signature restaurant with fine dining and fine wine; Mister Brown's Pub for lunch, dinner, and evening entertainment; Sagamore Dining Room, serving a gourmet buffet breakfast; and afternoon tea, raw bar, drinks, and a spectacular view of the lake in the glass-enclosed Veranda. The Club Grill, a New York-style steakhouse, overlooks the golf course and provides a casual setting for lunch and dinner. In season, there's also dining on *The Morgan*, a 72-foot yacht that cruises Lake George, and lakeside lunches and lobster bake dinners on the Pavilion.

Three separate meeting locations comprise more than 25,000 square feet of function space. The Historic Hotel offers six meeting rooms, including a 2,600-square-foot divisible room and a dedicated boardroom. The Conference Center boasts a state-of-the-art, 10,800-square-foot ballroom with banquet seating for 800 guests, plus three smaller rooms that hold up to 70. The Hermitage, a former carriage house, has a permanent boardroom for VIP gatherings. There's also the elegant Shelving Rock Terrace, a tented area for outdoor special events.
